- As a reward for their super focus, they were treated to a water-based PE lesson today where they undertook a range of challenges featuring water balloons. Some got wetter than others!

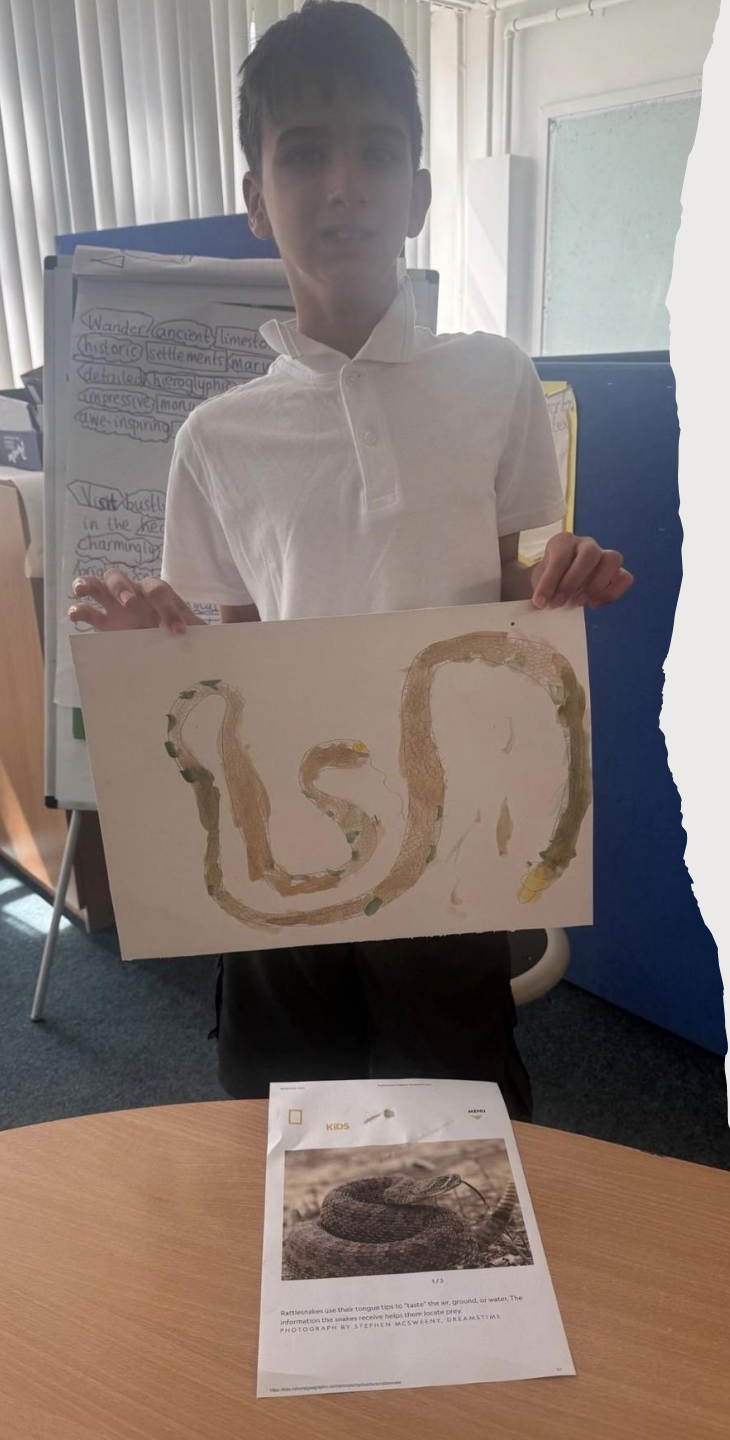


Celebrating Puffin Class
