
Carrington Junior School Summer Update

Pupil Premium funding greatly benefits children's learning and development as the school receives extra funding to assist children. If you are in receipt of certain benefits including Income Support, Job Seekers Allowance and Child Tax Credit and think you may be eligible for your child to receive this additional support, please contact Mrs Gardener (this term) or Mrs Woodhouse (next term) in confidence. No one will know you have registered and it will not affect any other benefits you are claiming. You do not have to have Free School Meals unless you want to but the option for your child to have Free lunches will be available to you.
